Helpful Information

Times

Gates open 7am, secretary tent opens 7.30am, Show jump Course walking commences at 8.30am for 9am start, all rings will commence at 9.15 am sharp.

Helmets will need to be check at secretary tent 8am – 9.00am

Catering

Will be available on the day until sold out

Attire

All riders are required to wear Horse Riding safety approved helmets ASA 3838 and riding boots at all times when mounted. So each school can easily be distinguished riders need to wear their school uniform shirt and tie, jumper or polo shirt. If your school has their colours and emblems with brow bands and saddle cloths they can also be worn.

(NO PLAITING & No Hacking Attire unless part of your school uniform, you will be asked to remove this attire if worn)

Responsibility

We require each school participating in the Kapunda & Light Agriculture Show in conjunction with Kapunda High Schools Gymkhana to nominate a supervisor, either a staff member or a parent to accept full responsibility for their school team members.

Kapunda & Light Agricultural Show Societies Inc. and the organisers will not accept responsibility for any damage or accident that may occur on the day. Waiver must be signed and given to Secretary.

Riders

Riders must ride in the Open **OR** the Encourage ring not both.

Awards

Ribbons awarded 1st to 4th place in each class in each ring. Champion and Reserve ribbons for Championship classes. Trophies, Horse feed & Prizes in selected classes.

Weather

If the ABC 1 News 7pm on Wednesday 23rd October 2019 broadcast predicts the weather forecast to be 36* and over for Friday 25th October 2019 in Nuriootpa, the event will be cancelled for the welfare of horses and riders.

Lunch Break

There will **NO** lunch break held during the day's events but riders will find time between events to do this, enabling the day to run more efficiently for everyone.

First Aid - All Competitors Please Note:

In the case of a fall of an athlete and/or a horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete and/or the horse must be cleared by the event's medical team before the athlete and/or the horse may be permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event.

It will be the responsibility of riders/owners to obtain clearance from the event medical team and/or their own selected veterinary surgeon in the event of either a fall of rider or horse or both.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **Post Entries & Payment on the day, entries will only be accepted by the secretary between 8am -9am.**
- Cash & Cheque payments on the day
- As a committee the decision has been made to offer a set entry fee of \$35 per combination, this one entry fee allows the riders to compete in all Hacking & Jumping rings all day, with the stipulation that a rider must choose compete either in Open or encourage ring NOT BOTH. The \$35 entry fee is inclusive of the \$5 parking fee.
- All riders must be currently enrolled at a South Australian Primary or High School
- **No refunds** without prior arrangements with the secretary and a medical certificate or veterinarian certificate may be required. Waiver must be signed and given to Secretary.
- NO STALLIONS OR COLTS permitted on grounds
- Classes will not be held, this is to ensure smooth running of the day's program
- Age is as on the day of the show (proof may be asked for)
- The organisers reserve the right to remove any unruly horse or person from the grounds for the safety & welfare of other horses/persons
- Lunging is NOT permitted in either the practice or warm up arenas
- Any protest must be made in writing and signed and handed to the show secretary with a \$50 fee. The protest must be lodged within 10 minutes of the event in question. The committee will determine the outcome of any protest. The fee will be returned should the protest be upheld.
- NO DOGS permitted on the grounds.
- All manure is to be removed and placed in bins before departure. All holes dug by horses while being tied up to be filled in. All hay cleaned up and put into manure bins.
- Committee reserves the right to alter program and classes as deemed necessary on the day.

- A. The Committee of the Kapunda & Light Agricultural Show Society Inc., in conjunction with Kapunda & Light Ag Show Schools Gymkhana and the Kapunda Harness Racing Club Inc., DO NOT accept any responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any personal property, horses, riders, spectators, or any other persons on any part of the Grounds or Facilities.

- E. WAIVER DISCLAIMER: if for any reason the entry form is not signed (in case of junior signed by a legal guardian as well) you will not be permitted to start.
