 Entries close All entries must be received by Wednesday 24 October with full payment
 Prize money All classes: 1st \$10; 2nd \$5
 The Convenors will pay prize money at 4.30pm at Section area
 Points 1st prize 5 points; 2nd prize 3 points; 3rd prize 1 point

- All animals to be judged as interbreed and must be registered in an appropriate Stud book in accordance with the appropriate breed regulations.
- The minimum status requirement is MN1 unless cattle are from a BJD free or Protected Zone or Beef Only
- All cattle are required to be tested for Pestivirus and certified as non-PI (persistently infected). Exhibitors must complete question 3b on the National Cattle Health Declaration stating this testing complete. Copies of test results listing animals and their identification must be submitted with entry forms.
- Please list MIY status and PIC on entry form. Entry form available from Show's website or available from the convenor. NVD forms must be presented on Show Day. No paperwork, not allowed within the show ring.
- All ages to be taken from 1st October 2017
- All cattle to be led into the ring. All cattle to have 2 points of contact at all times.
- Animals must be stalled at the showgrounds by 8.30am. No animals to be loaded and transported until 3.30pm.
- Classes may be changed at the convenor and stewards discretion
- Judging commences at 10am.
- Arrival and camping on the Friday 26 October is available at a cost of \$15 per group
